WE ARE on a mission to prevent child sexual abuse, and we need your help!

The Child Maltreatment Solutions Network has partnered with several PA counties, including Somerset and Cambria, as part of the Safe and Healthy Communities Initiative. This initiative reaches into schools, families, and the community-at-large with evidence-informed programming. Never have these programs been strategically deployed in combination – our strategy is innovative and is geared to reduce the occurrence of child sexual abuse.

One of our goals is to reach 5% of the adults in each county with a program called *Stewards of Children*. This is a two-hour workshop teaches adults how to prevent, recognize, and react responsibly to child sexual abuse. Stewards of Children can be taken online, at your own pace, or via webinar led by an authorized facilitator. The webinars are available throughout the week but can also be scheduled at your groups' convenience.

WE ARE asking Penn State Alumni to complete the program and join us in creating a safe and healthy PA.

WE ARE also asking that you share this opportunity with any of your clients, any civic or social connections you can leverage, any employees you could introduce to the program, your friends, and your family. Anyone over 18 can benefit from and have an impact as a Stewards of Children. Free continuing education credits are available for social workers, nurses, teachers, dentists/dental hygienists, early childhood educators (PQAS), and licensed professional counselors.
